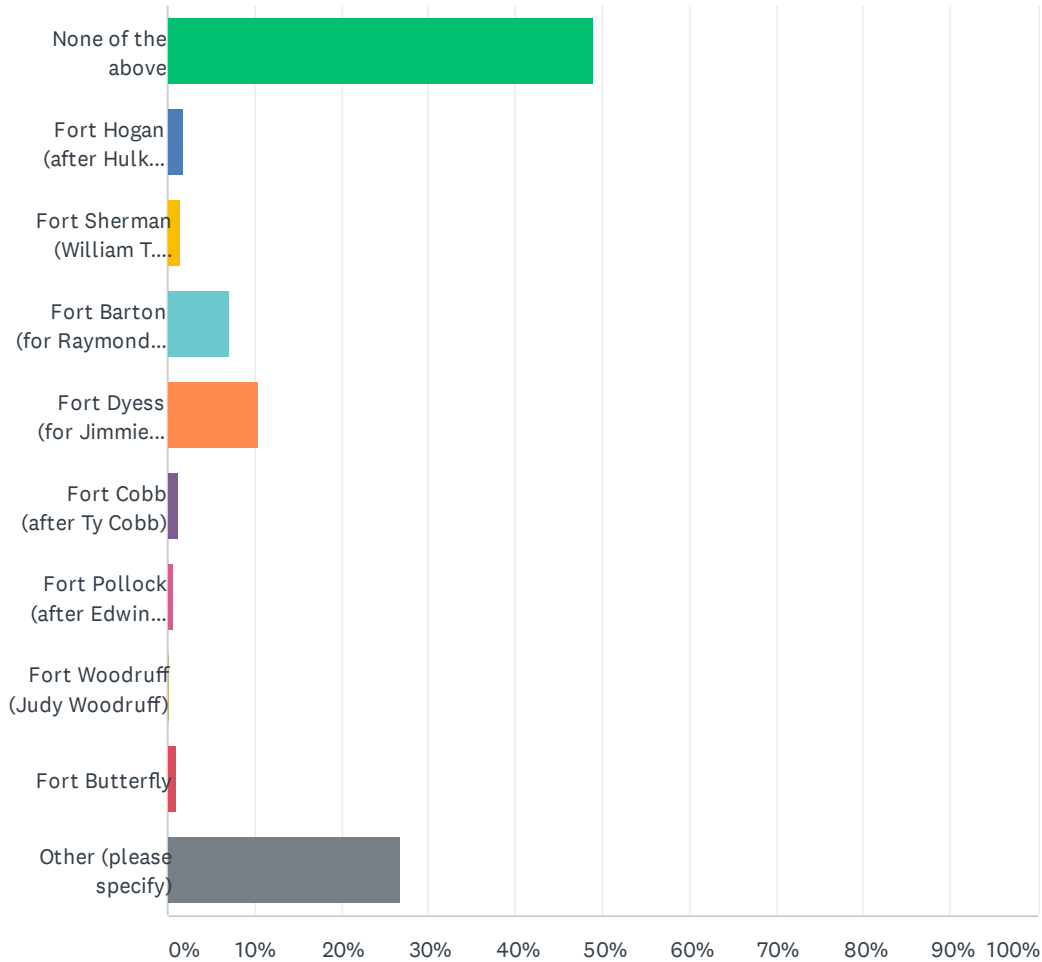


Q1 Out of the options below which name is best to rename "Fort Gordon"?

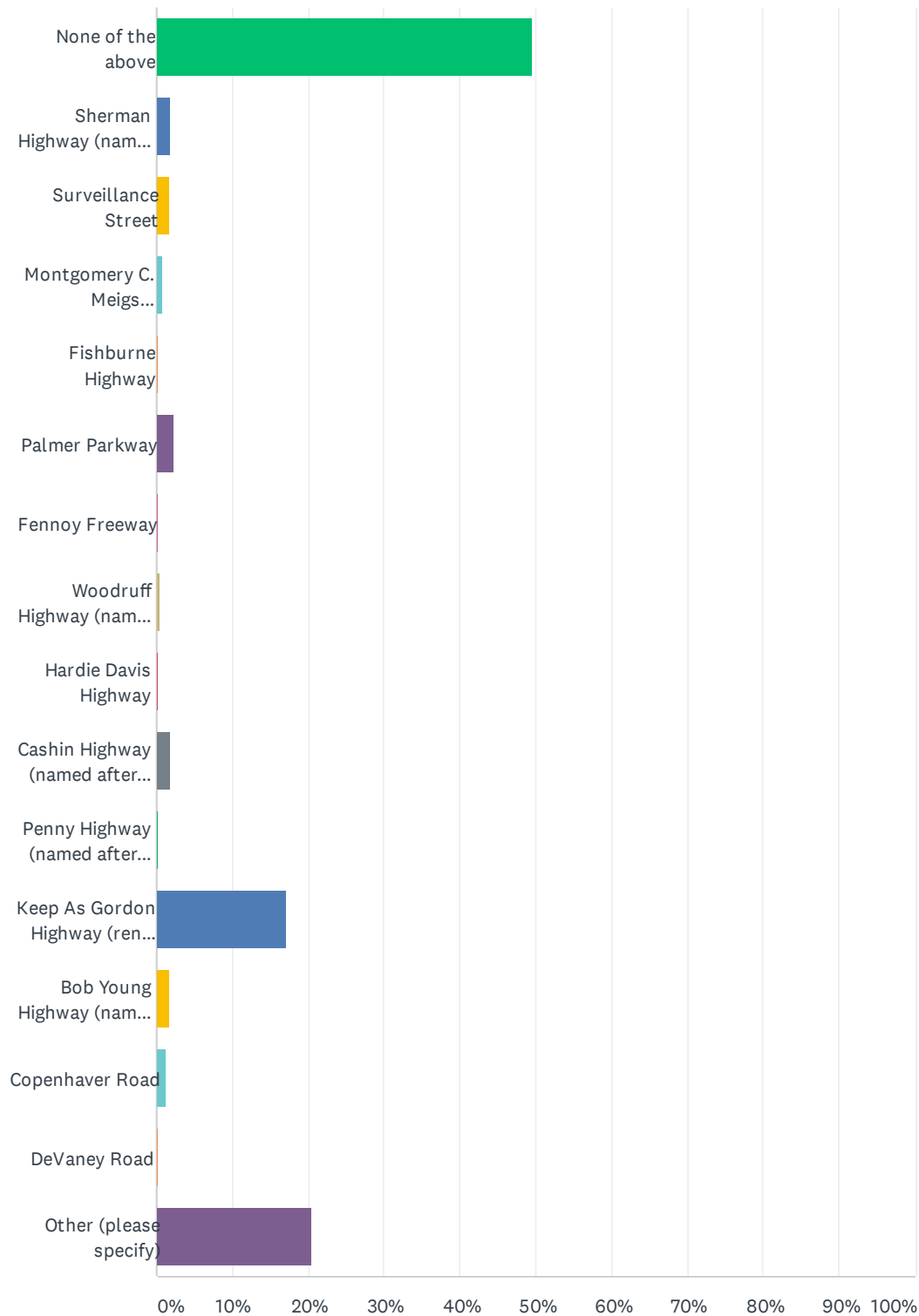
